Weekly Report Ending 07/14/2019

Milton Rescue Department

For the week ending 07/14/2019 Milton Rescue responded to 18 calls for service resulting in 16 transports. For the calendar year 2019 Milton Rescue has responded to 503 calls for service. This week calls included a mutual-aid response to Route 2 in Colchester, north of Chimney Corners, for a multi-vehicle accident and standby medical support for an active chimney fire on Cold Spring Road.

During the last week Rescue also responded to at least three heat related injuries. Heat exhaustion and heat stroke can quickly become medical emergencies. Signs and symptoms of heat exhaustion include headache, dizziness, weakness, and cold, pale, clammy skin or heavy sweating. Exhaustion becomes heat stroke when a patient becomes altered, unware of their surroundings, and unable to change help themselves cool down. This is a true medical emergency!
