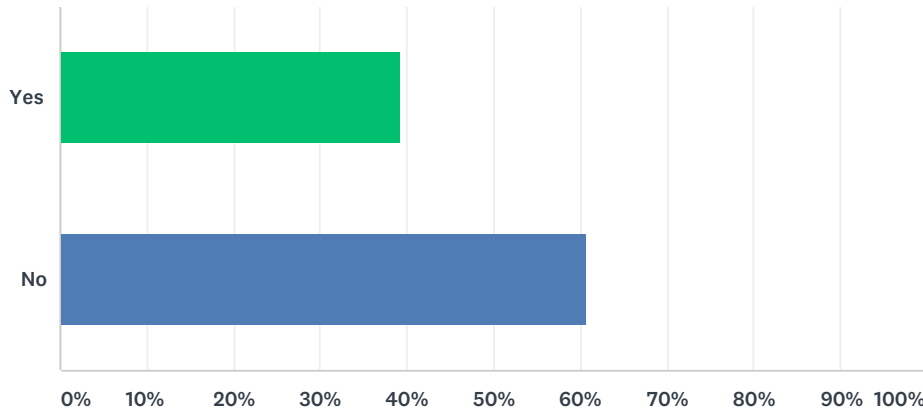


Q1 Do you believe that Milton has an adequate number of child care facilities?

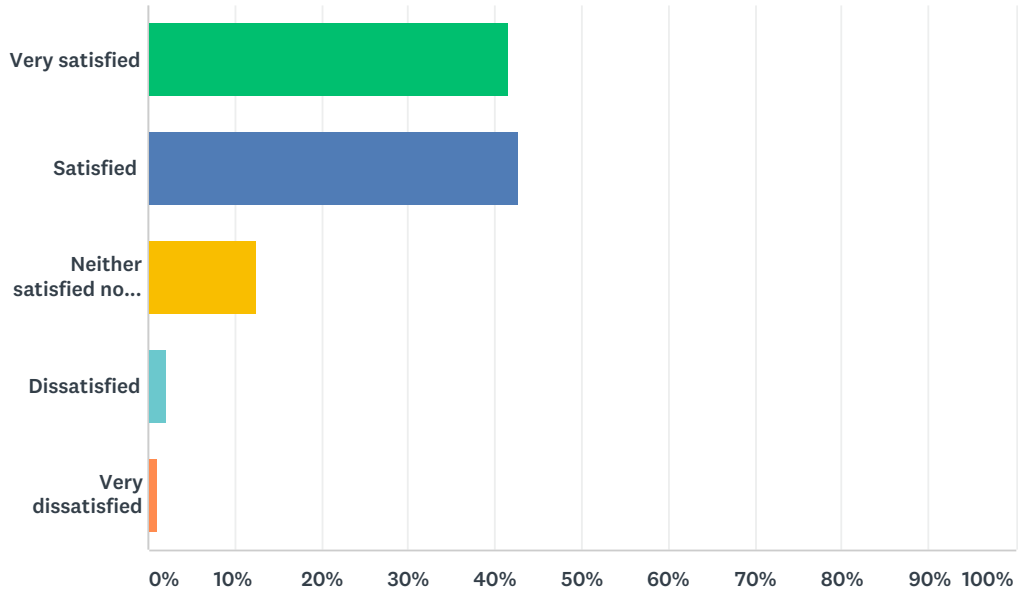

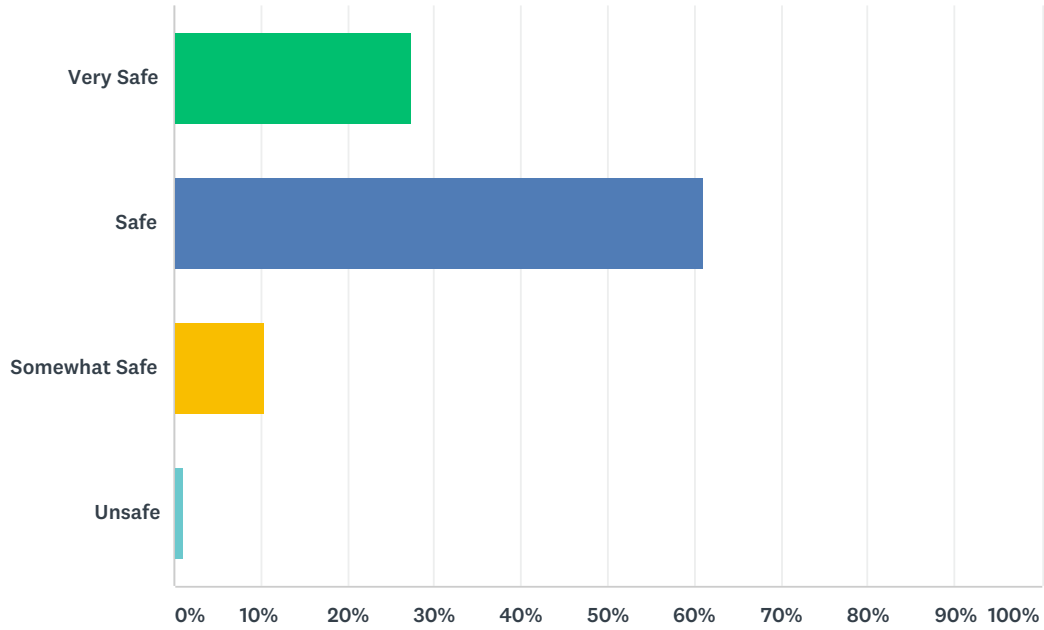

Q4 How safe do you feel living in Milton?

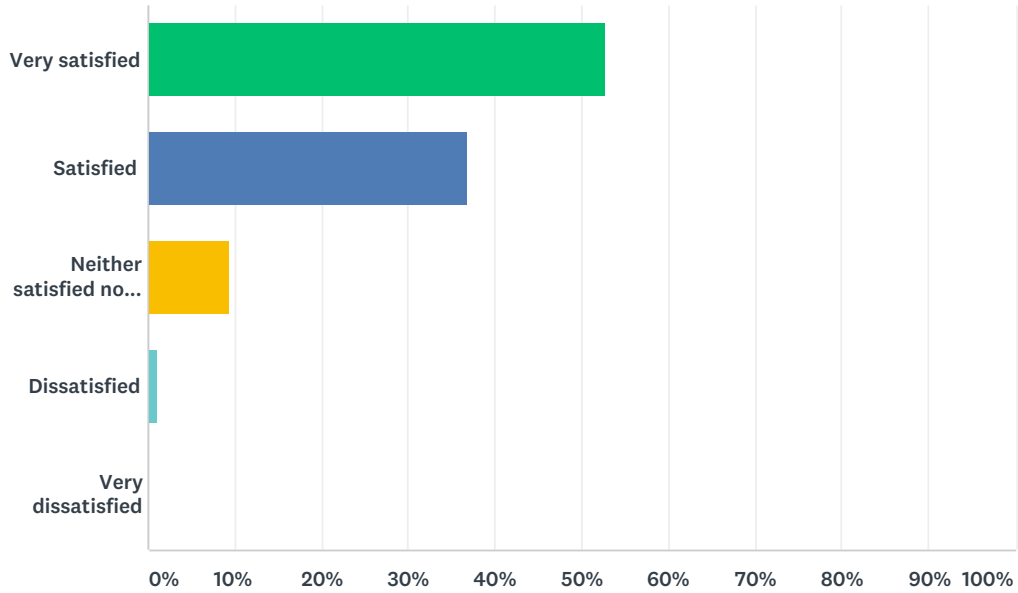
