PRESS RELEASE

Friday, June 27, 2014

On June 26th, 2014 at approximately 11:10 PM, Milton Police Officer William Bosworth was on patrol when he noticed a suspicious vehicle with its lights off parked at the TD Bank ATM located on US Route 7 in Milton.

At that time, the officer observed the two male occupants of the vehicle arguing while the vehicle was pulling around the backside of the bank and stopped. Officer Bosworth then heard what he believed to be a gunshot coming from that direction.

Upon investigation, it was determined the driver of the vehicle identified as Philip Katon (Age 46) of Milton had discharged a .22 caliber 5 shot cap and ball revolver. Katon fired the revolver in the direction of the Milton High School sports field and running track area. People sometimes run on this track at that time of night.

Katon was taken into custody and the male passenger John Malcolm (age 34) of St. Albans was also taken into custody on an outstanding arrest warrant for credit card fraud.

Katon was charged with the crime of Reckless Endangering. Reckless Endangering carries a penalty of not more than one year or fined not more than \$1,000.00 or both.

Katon was processed and released on a citation to appear in Chittenden County Superior Court-Criminal Division for the date of July 24th, 2014 at 8:30 AM.

Malcolm was lodged on the outstanding warrant at the Chittenden County Correctional Facility.
