# PRESS RELEASE

## April 1, 2015

### UPDATE

On April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015 the Milton Police Department arrested and charged Zachary Rose (Age 25) of Milton in connection with the stolen truck taken on March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015. With the assistance of the public, Police were able to identify Rose from security picture as the person that shoplifted items from Aubuchon Hardware store in Milton, and then stole a truck belonging to the Building Home Center.

The truck was later located on March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015 in Essex, VT and returned to the owner.

Rose who was currently on probation and Pre-Trial Conditions of release for other charges was issued a citation for April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015 for the charges of Aggravated Operation of a Motor Vehicle Without Owner's Consent (Felony) and Petit Larceny.

The crime of Aggravated Operation of a Motor Vehicle Without Owner's Consent carries a penalty of imprisonment of not more than five years or fined not more than \$2,000.00, or both.

On March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at approximately 2:45pm the Building Home Center located on US Route 7 reported that one of their work trucks had been stolen. Upon arrival of Milton Police Officers, it was determined that a blue 2003 Chevrolet pickup truck Vermont registration DG888 had been stolen sometime between 12:00pm and 2:45pm. The truck was described to have the business logo on the doors "Building Home Center" and a black latter rack on the back.

Based on evidence at the scene it was determine a lone person checked multiple other vehicles in the lot of the Building Home Center before stealing the truck. The suspect left a back pack behind at the scene, which Police were able to determine its contents were stolen from the Aubuchon Hardware store in Milton at 1:00pm.
