Re: Recognition of persons who serve on the Selectboard
Date: May 7, 2007

EFFECTIVE DATE - Immediately

PURPOSE: To recognize those persons serving as a Member of the Selectboard who gave their time and resources for the betterment of the Town of Milton.

PROCEDURE: A Selectboard Recognition plaque is displayed in the Municipal Complex, Community Room. Name plates are placed on the plaque as soon as practicable, engraved with the name of the individual, the year(s) of service of Members of the Selectboard. Members will have one name plate on the plaque, therefore those persons serving with a break in years of service, the name plate will be engraved with all terms served on one name plate. The expense for name plates and engraving will be part of the Selectboard Budget.

In addition to the name plate on the Selectboard Recognition Plaque, Members of the Selectboard who serve three or fewer consecutive years on the Selectboard will receive a letter of recognition signed by current Members of the Selectboard.

Members who serve four or more consecutive years will receive a resolution recognizing their years of service to the citizens of the Town of Milton, signed by current members of the Selectboard and a wall mountable plaque. The expense for such items will be part of the Selectboard budget.

POLICY:

The Milton Selectboard, acting in regular session on May 7, 2007 voted in favor of the following;

"Voted in favor of the Selectboard Recognition Policy 07, as outlined above.

Further that this referenced Policy shall be part of the permanent record by attachment of the same to the Minutes of the aforementioned Meeting."
