Re: Policy 98-01 Winter Sand
Date: January 16, 1998

EFFECTIVE DATE - Immediately

PURPOSE: Over the past several years, residents/taxpayers of the Town of Milton have had access to sand/salt mixture, in small quantities, for their private use. Along with this came issues with large amounts of the mixture being taken for various uses. The Town of Milton has a responsibility for the public safety in traveling on roads and streets. An integral part of this safety is the acquisition, storage and application of winter sand. Typically the Highway Department requires from 5,000 - 6,500 c.y. of material per season for all types of winter storm maintenance. As a result, the Policy below was created.

PROCEDURE: The Town of Milton does not financially prepare to provide winter sand for commercial winter storm maintenance of any type. Private citizens/residents/taxpayers will have the right to obtain 1 five (5) gallon bucket of sand, for their private use, per event. Town employees are hereby requested to advise citizens/residents/taxpayers of the need to use discretion in their sand supply needs.

POLICY: The Milton Select Board, acting in regular session on January 19, 1998 voted in favor of the following;

"Voted that the citizens/residents and taxpayers of the Town of Milton are permitted to obtain 1 five (5) gallon bucket of sand for their private use, per event as outlined in Policy 98-01.

Further that this referenced Policy shall be part of the permanent record by attachment of the same to the Minutes of the aforementioned Meeting."
