Tuesday, August 28, 2012

On August 21st, 2012 the Milton Police Department requested assistance in identifying the operator of a pickup truck involved in a vandalism incident at Cobble Hill Trailer Sales in Milton. Information provided by citizens proved helpful with the identification.

The owner of the vehicle and the passenger both came to the Milton Police station after they saw the information put out to the media. The owner of the vehicle, who also was the driver during the incident, was identified as 21 year-old Dylan Martell of South Hero. The passenger was 22 year-old Cameron Stommel of Milton.

Both Martell and Stommel admitted their involvement in the incident. Stommel fired a roman candle at two parked semi-trailers, which created a hole in the outside material of one of the semi-trailers. Martell then performed a 360-degree maneuver in the parking lot with his truck. This maneuver is commonly referred to a "doughnut."

Stommel was cited into court for Unlawful Mischief and Possession of Fireworks. Both are misdemeanors. Martell was cited into court for misdemeanor Unlawful Mischief. Both have a court date of October 4th, 2012.
