On October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2012 the Milton Police Department charged Keith McGregor (age 26) of Winooski in connection with the burglary that occurred at Rene's Deli and Discount Beverage store on the night of August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012.

McGregor was charged with Burglary, Unlawful Mischief, Sale of Stolen Property and Violation of Pre-Trial Conditions of Release. He was issued a citation through his attorney to appear in Chittenden County Superior Court-Criminal Division on the date of November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2012 to answer the charges.

## Original Press Release

In the early morning of August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012 between the hours of 2:18 am and 2:20 am, Rene's Deli and Discount Beverage, located at 105 River Street (US Route 7) in Milton was burglarized. The building sustained damage to the front glass door that was smashed.

Surveillance video inside the store showed a lone male described as approximately 5'3" in height, thin build, wearing a hooded jack, gloves, pants and sneakers entered the business by smashing the front door glass. The male then stole a large amount of cigarettes and fled the store on foot.

The security video also shows vehicles passing by the store before, during and after the burglary. Therefore, the Milton Police Department would like to speak with anyone that may have passed by the store during this time frame.
