

Frequently Frequently Asked Questions

How many members do you have?

Milton Rescue currently has 45 volunteer members. We provide coverage to the Town of Milton and assist when requested to the surrounding towns. Members are scheduled to run one 12 hour shift from 6 am to 6 pm, or 6 pm to 6 am as well as up to two 12 hour weekend shifts per month.

Do you have someone at the station?

Milton Rescue is still a volunteer service we do not staff someone to be at the station at all times, however many of our members do stay at the station during their shifts. If you have an emergency it is best you call 9-1-1 from the location you're at instead of going to the station.

What are the levels of certification on the department?

We have 4 levels of certifications within our department those are CPR Certified, First Responder, Basic and Intermediate. CPR certified are those who have only completed the initial CPR training and are waiting to enter a First responder or EMT-B course. First Responder is a 40 hour course that provides the basic information to provide care. Emergency Medical Technician Basic (EMT-B) This is a 110 hour course that teaches recognition and management of life saving procedures EMT-Intermediate, this is a 83 hour course which allows members to provide medications and insert IV's to those who need one en route to the Hospital. At this time Milton Rescue is not licensed as a Paramedic service. If Paramedic care is needed it is requested from neighboring towns.

I received a bill after being transported to the emergency room.

Milton Rescue contracts with Certified Ambulance Group (CAG) out of Wethersfield Connecticut. They have been with us for over 4 years providing us with revenue recovery for EMS transports.
