Press Release

On May 6th, 2008, the Milton Police Department received a report of a motor vehicle crash on Bear Trap Road, by U.S. Route 2 in the town of Milton.

Upon arrival of the investigating officers, it was discovered that the operator Caryn L. Bartlett, age 37 of Milton, had been thrown from the vehicle, a 1998 Chevy Blazer. The passenger Todd Charbonneau, age 36 of Milton, was still inside the vehicle, and needed to be extricated by the Milton Fire Department. Contained inside the vehicle were a number of power tools and equipment.

While at the accident scene, the Milton Police Department received a report of a residential burglary on Bear Trap Road. Upon investigation, it was discovered that numerous power tools and equipment had been stolen. The victim was then brought to the accident scene and subsequently identified some of the tools as the ones stolen from his residence.

A short time later, a second burglary was reported at an additional residence on Bear Trap Road, near the first reported burglary.

The vehicle was seized and a search warrant was obtained for the vehicle. As a result of the search, property was recovered from both burglaries.

The operator Caryn Bartlett and her passenger Todd Charbonneau were charged with (2) two counts of burglary. Charbonneau was on supervised release from the Dept. of Corrections at the time of the burglaries.

A person convicted of burglary shall be imprisoned not more than 15 years or fined not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
