PRESS RELEASE

On February 19, 2014, at approximately 0029 hours, the Milton Police Department responded to a report of a residential burglary and assault which had just occurred on Boysenberry Drive in the Town of Milton, Chittenden County.

Investigation revealed that the suspect, identified as Natalie Kirk DOB 09-06-1990 of Essex Junction, forcibly entered the residence by smashing in the door. Kirk then assaulted one of the female occupants of the residence who was sleeping.

Kirk fled the scene, but was apprehended by a Milton Police Officer a short distance down the road. Kirk was taken into custody without incident.

The victim sustained non-life threatening facial injuries and abrasions and was transported to Fletcher Allen Health Care by Milton Rescue for treatment.

Kirk was lodged at the Chittenden County Correctional Center for lack of \$5,000.00 bail. Kirk is scheduled to appear in Chittenden Superior Court, Criminal Division today at 1030 hours to answer to the following charges:

Burglary, a violation of Title 13, VSA section 1201;

Aggravated Assault, a violation of Title 13, VSA section 1024;

Driving while License Suspended, a violation of Title 23 VSA section 674;

Violation of Conditions of Release, a violation of Title 13, VSA section 7559.

-Burglary is a felony with a maximum penalty of 25 years imprisonment, \$1000.00 or both.

-Aggravated Assault is a felony with a maximum penalty of 15 years imprisonment, \$10,000.00 or both.

-Driving while License Suspended is a misdemeanor with a maximum penalty of not more than two years imprisonment or fine of not more than \$5,000.00 or both.

-Violation of Conditions of Release is a misdemeanor with a maximum penalty of not more than 6 months imprisonment, \$1,000.00 or both.
