PRESS RELEASE

On November 11th, 2010 the Milton Police Department charged **Scott P. Allen (Age 41) of Highgate, VT** with charges of Burglary, Larceny from a Motor Vehicle, Unlawful Mischief, Sale of Stolen Property and Credit Card Fraud.

These charges stemmed from an investigation by the Milton Police into multiple thefts from motor vehicles occurring in Milton. In these such thefts victims found their vehicle windows smashed and items such as GPS units, cell phones, wallets and hunting items stolen from their vehicles. Victims also later noticed that their credit cards that were stolen had been used at multiple locations fraudulently.

Through investigation as well as witness statements, and security video of the fraudulent credit card usages; Police located (2) possible suspects. Police obtained (2) two search warrant for the suspect's residences located at 146 Parizo Road in Highgate, VT and 304 US Route 2 in South Hero, VT. Upon execution of the search warrant, police found stolen property that proved Scott Allen (Age 41) and his brother **Dean L. Allen (Age 43) of South Hero** had not only committed the thefts from motor vehicles and credit card frauds, but were also involved in burglaries and other thefts in both Franklin and Chittenden County.

At the time of the search warrants Scott Allen confessed to doing these thefts, credit card frauds and burglaries throughout both counties. Dean Allen was not present at the time of the search warrants. It was found that Dean Allen had an active arrest warrant in Vermont for other unrelated charges. At this time an additional arrest warrant has been applied for on these current charges for Dean Allen.

Scott Allen was charged with Burglary, Larceny from a Motor Vehicle, Unlawful Mischief, Sale of Stolen Property and Credit Card Fraud. He will appear in Chittenden County Superior Court on November 19th, 2010 and in Franklin County Superior Court on November 22nd, 2010.
