PRESS RELEASE

Wednesday, September 03, 2008

On Monday, June 2nd, 2008 the Milton Police Department were called to the Milton Building Supply located on U.S. Route 7 in the town of Milton for a report of a Burglary. Investigation revealed that between the hours of 11:00 pm -11:30 pm on June 1st, 2008 at least one person entered the storage lot behind the business and stolen approximately \$13,000 worth of building materials.

The suspect(s) operated the Milton Building Supply fork lift in order to put large pallets of building materials onto the red 1990 Ford F900 flat bed/boom truck with VT registration plate APX471. This vehicle was also owned by Milton Building Supply.

The suspect(s) then left in the truck in an unknown direction of travel. The Milton Building Supply truck was returned to the business later that night before the crime was discovered.

Stolen were multiple new 6 panel interior doors, silver line double hung windows, masonite interior doors, Velux sky light units, Termal-Tru 6 panel exterior door, Peachtree French doors. As well as thousands of dollars of IKO shingles (Grey, Slate and charcoal). Also stolen were IKO ice and water shield (65 foot rolls) and Grace Ice and water shield (75 foot rolls).

On September 3rd, 2008 the Milton Police Department arrested **MARK C. RYAN DOB: 07/09/1984 (24 yrs old) of Milton** in connection with the Milton Building Supply Burglary on June 2nd, 2008. Mark C. Ryan was charged with Burglary (Felony) and Aggravated Operation of a Motor Vehicle without Owner's Consent (Felony).

Mark Ryan was also arrested and charged in connection with a separate residential Burglary that occurred on August 31st, 2008 on West Milton Road in the Town of Milton.

Mark Ryan will be arraigned on Wednesday September 3rd, 2008 at 1300 hours in Chittenden County Court for the combined charges. He was later lodged at the Chittenden County Correctional Center on lack of \$50,000 bail.

Burglary (Felony) carries a punishment up to 15 years in prison and/or fined not more than \$1,000.00, or both.

Aggravated Operation Without Consent of Owner (Felony) carries a punishment up to no more than five years or fined not more than \$2,000.00, or both.
